We have seen improvements in the percentage of students meeting or exceeding expectations in English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science across various grade levels. This growth reflects the hard work and dedication of our students and teachers.
- **Accountability and Progress Toward Improvement Targets:** Our school is making substantial progress toward meeting the state's accountability measures. We are on track to achieve our improvement targets in areas such as student achievement, growth, and high school completion. This progress is a testament to the collective efforts of our entire school community.
